In order to use this form, one of the following must be met. Check applicable box(s) and complete the information below and provide any supporting documentation to include any police reports.

I received the notice of violation and at the time of the violation,

- At the time of the violation, the motor vehicle was in the care, custody, or control of another person. The individual who may be held liable for the violation is provided below.
- Vehicle, license plate/tag was stolen and was operated by a person other than the registered owner **(include a copy of the police report)**.
- Registered Owner was deceased on or before the date of the alleged violation (include death certificate and one of the following):
 - A bill of sale or other document showing that the deceased owner's motor vehicle was sold or transferred after his or her death but on or before the date of the alleged violation, or
 - Documented proof that the registered license plate belonging to the deceased owner's motor vehicle was returned to The Palm Beach County Tax Collector's Office or any branch office or authorized agent of the The Palm Beach County Tax Collector's Office after his or her death but on or before the date of the alleged violation, or
 - A copy of the police report showing that the deceased owner's registered license plate or motor vehicle was stolen after his/her death but on or before the date of the alleged violation.
- A uniform traffic citation for a violation of Florida Statute §316.1895 or §316.183 was issued at the location of the violation by a law enforcement officer (include a copy of the citation or provide the citation number).
